Happy New Year. Attached is the South Carolina BMP Courtesy Exam Report for December 2019. Four sites were closed out during the month. All of these sites were harvested in compliance with applicable BMPs and no water quality impacts resulted from these forest operations.

BMPs were properly applied by those responsible on all four sites this month and did not require any recommendations from a BMP Forester during the operation to assist with compliance.

In December, the BMP staff began locating sites for the 2020 BMP Compliance Monitoring Report. Monitoring studies are completed every three years, the results generate the published BMP compliance rate along with illustrating strengths and opportunities for improvement in statewide BMP compliance and implementation. The BMP Foresters will be focused on completing all of the field inspections over the next two months so the monthly Courtesy Exam Report numbers may be lower than normal.
